Mike, my apologies to the Mayor and Common Council for this late request. would you please place the following attached resolution as an addendum to the Tuesday, September 22, 2020 Common Council meeting agenda. I just received the information from Crandall Public Library today. The Common Council must **approve** the proposed resolution in order to have it placed on the ballot at the City's 8 polling locations for the City of Glens Falls at the Tuesday, November 6, 2018 General Election.

The Crandall Public Library Board of Trustees has adopted an approved proposed 2021 budget of \$ 4,859,906.00 (with the City's share to be \$ 937,522.00) that must be approved by the voters on November 6th. The attached resolution – similar in wording to past resolutions – **must be worded verbatim** for proposed Common Council passage on September 22nd. After that, I must get a certified copy of the proposed resolution to the Warren County Board of Elections by September 28th .

On the motion of _____, seconded by _____,

WHEREAS, the laws of 1992, Chapter 456 authorized the establishment of the Crandall Public Library District for the City of Glens Falls, in the County of Warren and the Town of Moreau, in the County of Saratoga and the Town of Queensbury, in the County of Warren; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid legislation provides that the proposition relating to the Crandall Public Library District be placed on the ballot at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has adopted and approved a budget for 2021 for the Crandall Public Library.

WHEREAS, the proposition to be determined is follows:

- (1) Whether the annual budget for 2021 as proposed by the Board of Trustees of the Crandall Public Library shall be approved or disapproved; and**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Crandall Public Library have requested that the City of Glens Falls adopt a resolution authorizing the placement of (1) proposition concerning the above issue on the ballot of the November 3, 2020 General Election for the voters' approval or disapproval;

IT IS RESOLVED, that the City of Glens Falls hereby approves and authorizes the placement of the following one (1) proposition pertaining to the Crandall Public Library District on the ballot in all the voting locations in the City of Glens Falls on the General Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2020;
